

Proposed 2027 Budget Two Rivers Watershed District

The Two Rivers Watershed District will hold a budget hearing pursuant to Minnesota Statute 103D.911 to consider and approve its proposed 2027 budget on Thursday, September 3, 2026 beginning at 8:00 am in the District office located in the Kittson County Courthouse, 410 S 5th Street, Suite 112, Hallock, Minnesota. Following the hearing, the Board of Managers also considered the 2027 general fund ad valorem tax levy, under law not to exceed the lesser of .096 percent of taxable market value or \$500,000, to be levied over the taxable market value within the boundaries of the District.

An additional ad valorem tax set under law by the Red River Watershed Management Board will be considered in the amount of 0.0003627 times the taxable market value on taxable property within the watershed district. For 2027 the Red River Watershed Management Board has certified their levy at 75% of the maximum amount which equals \$1,083,911 within the Two Rivers Watershed District. 2027 Ditch levies for all legal ditches under the jurisdiction of the District will also be considered at the hearing.
