As you may know, the Two Rivers Watershed District (TRWD) has recently been working to update its existing Watershed Management Plan. This is a requirement under MN Statute 103D and is intended to guide the TRWD Board of Managers and staff in conducting daily, monthly and yearly business and in planning and carrying out its various programs and projects. The plan is updated every 10 years.

You are receiving this information as required by MN Statute 103D.401. A 60 day comment period is currently open until November 15, 2026. At the end of the 60 day comment period, we will answer any written comments received and the Board of Managers will schedule a public hearing. At the hearing any persons affected or interested in the watershed district may attend and give statements.

The revised plan will then be submitted to the MN Board of Water & Soil Resources for approval. Please let me know if you have any questions or would like further information regarding this plan or the process that will be followed to revise and update it.
